Royal Court Parties

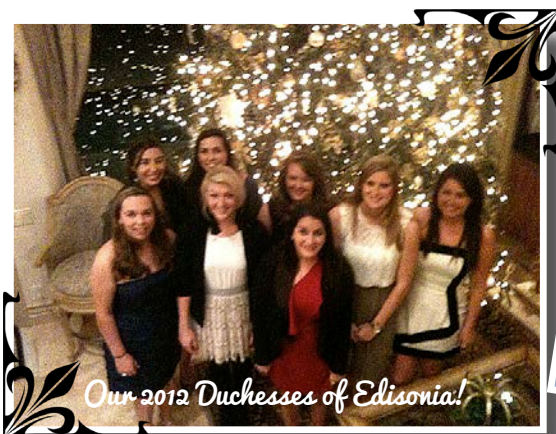

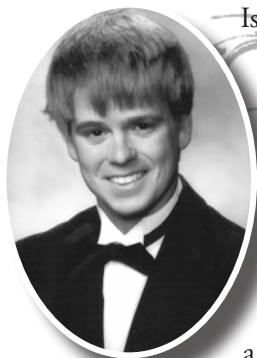
Prince John Travis Cowart

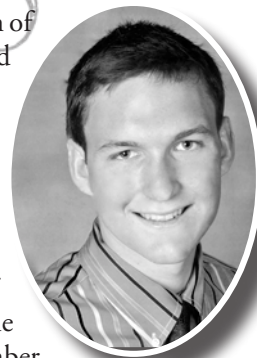
and operator of the Island Store and Captiva Liquors, both businesses

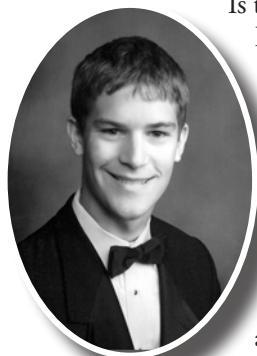
Prince Jordan Howard Griffin

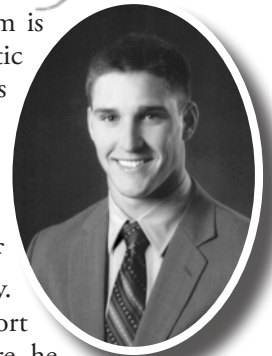

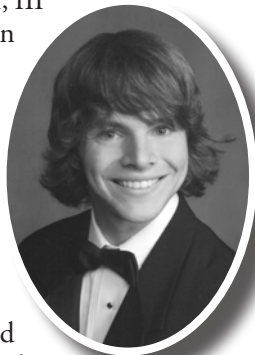
Prince Timothy Michael Raber
